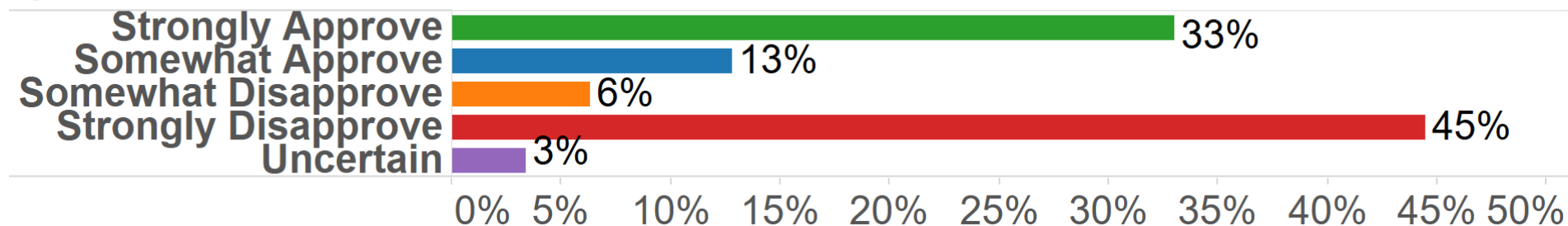

Executive Summary

Gravis Marketing, a nonpartisan research firm, conducted a random survey of 884 likely voters across Delaware. The poll was conducted from July 24th through the 29th and has a margin of error of $\pm 3.3\%$. The totals may not round to 100% because of rounding. The survey was conducted using an online panel of cell phone users and interactive voice responses. The results are weighted by voting demographics. The poll was paid for by Gravis Marketing.

4) Do you strongly approve, somewhat approve, somewhat disapprove, or strongly disapprove of President Trump's job performance?

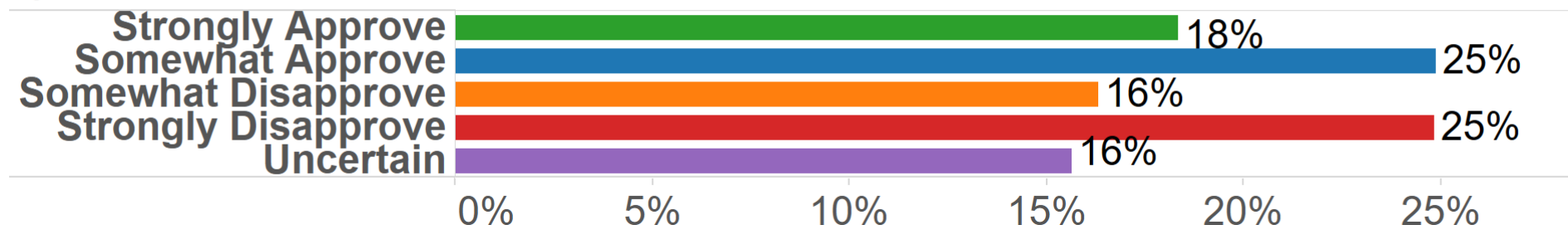

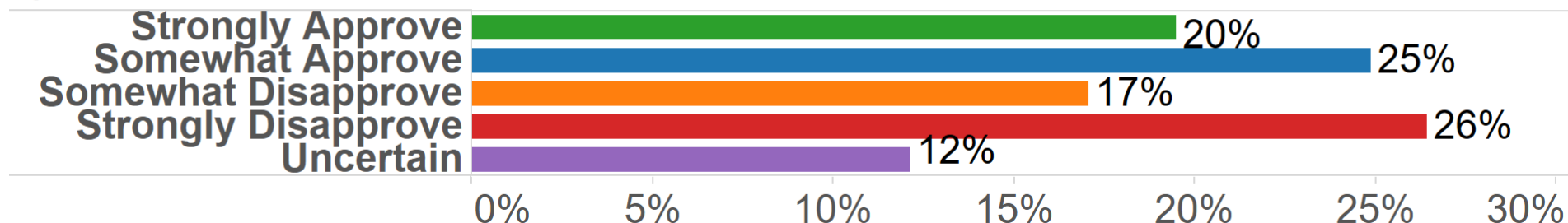

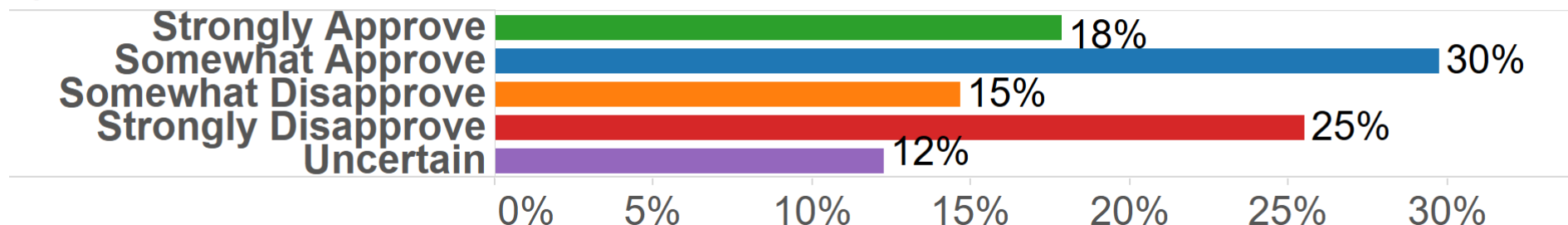

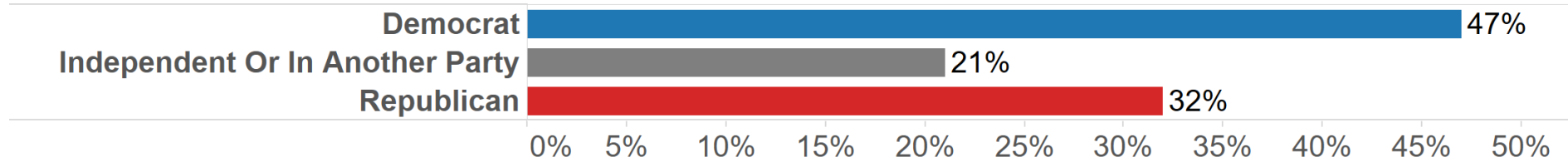

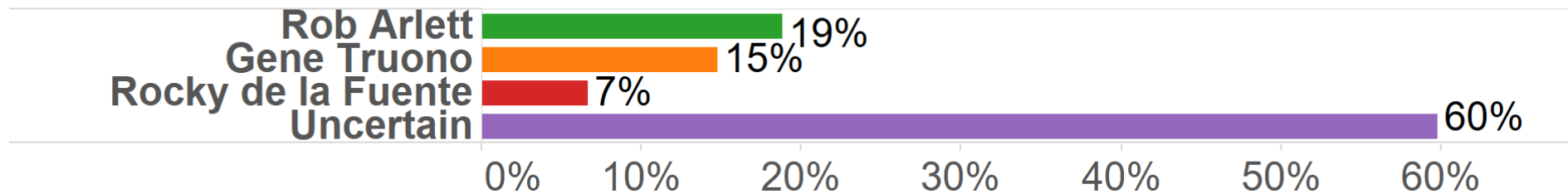

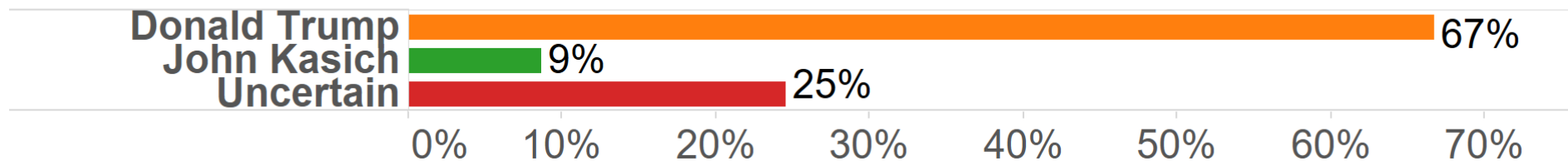

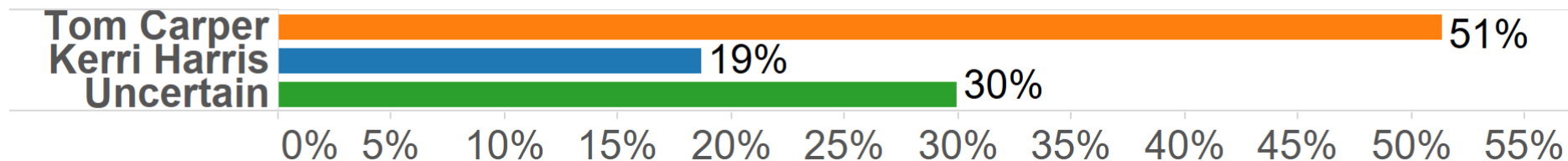

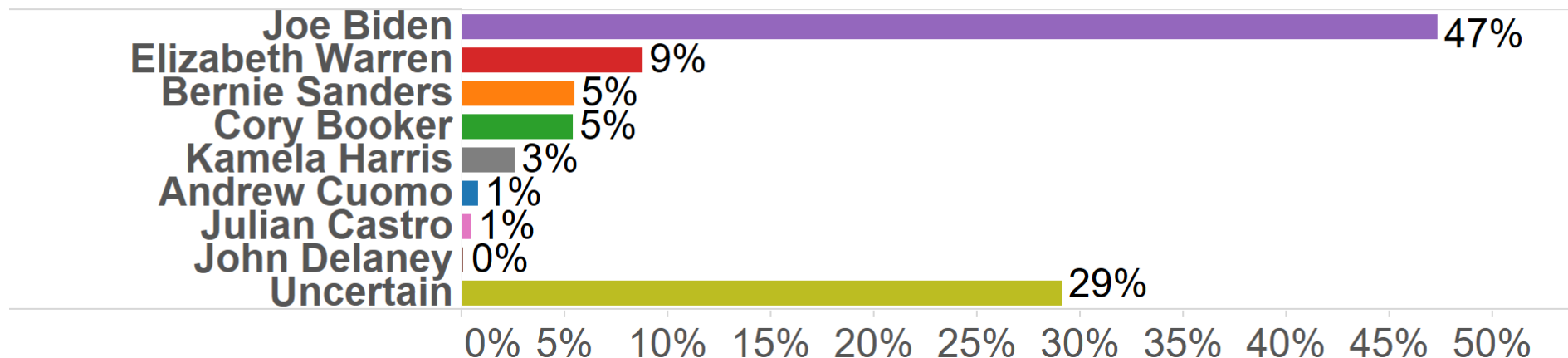

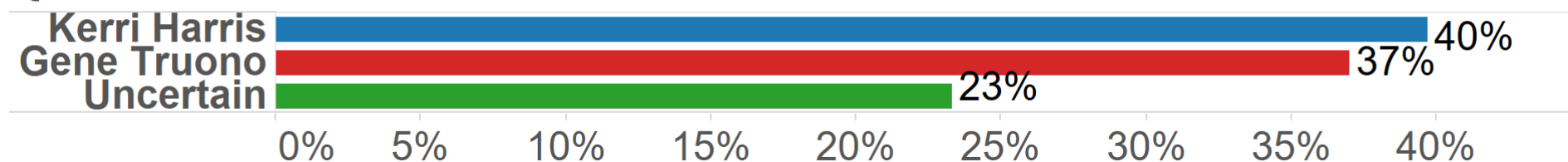

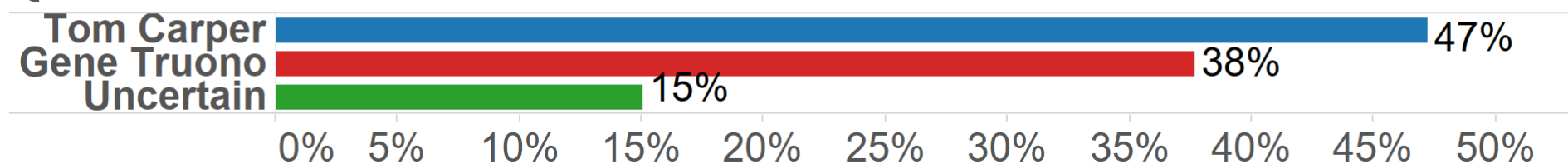

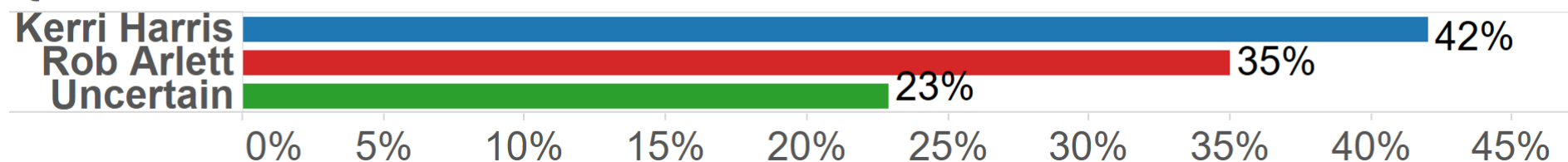

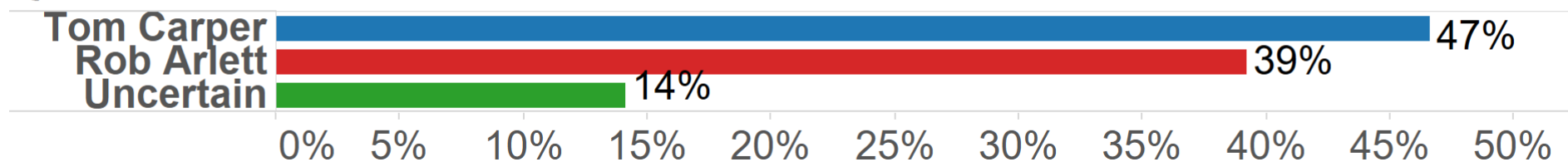

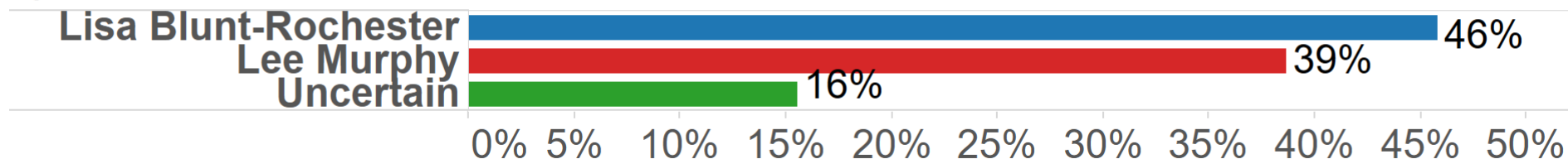

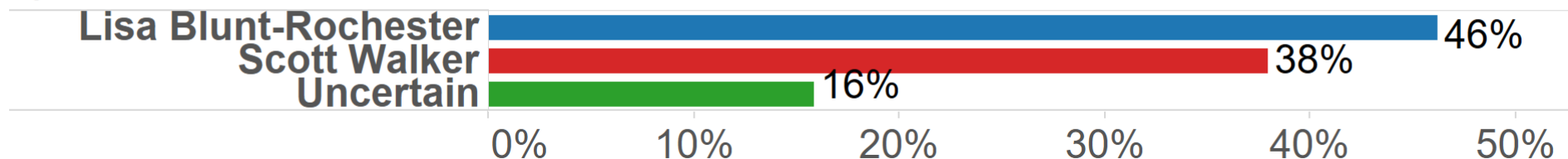

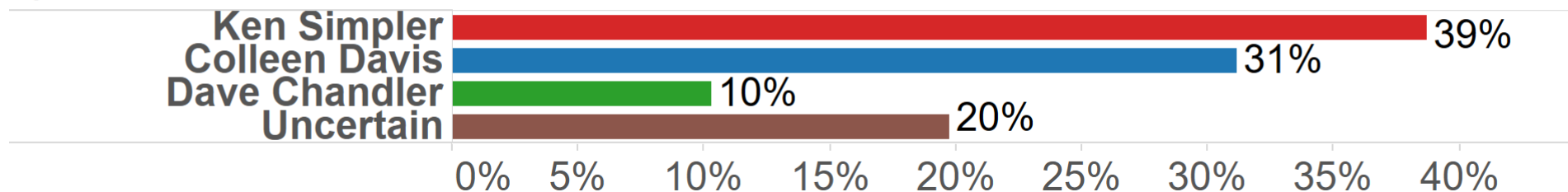

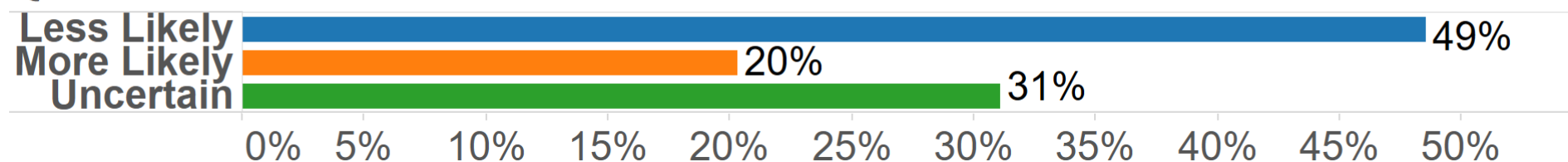

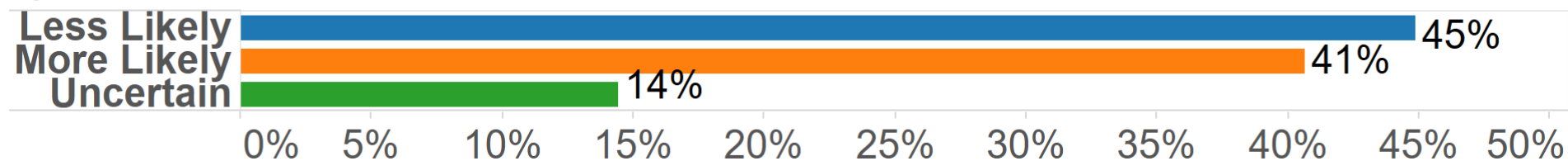

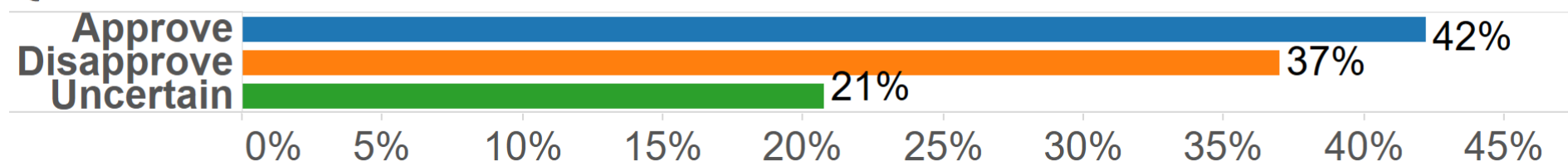

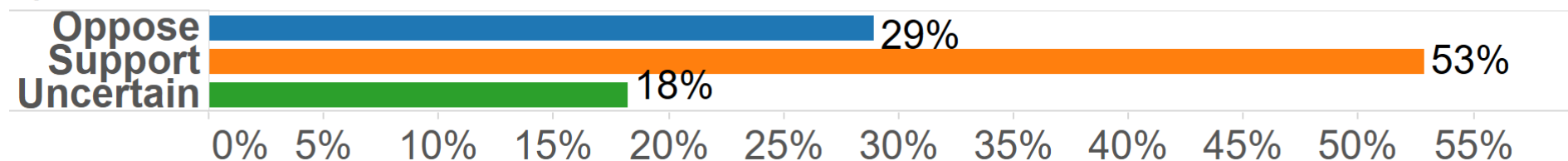

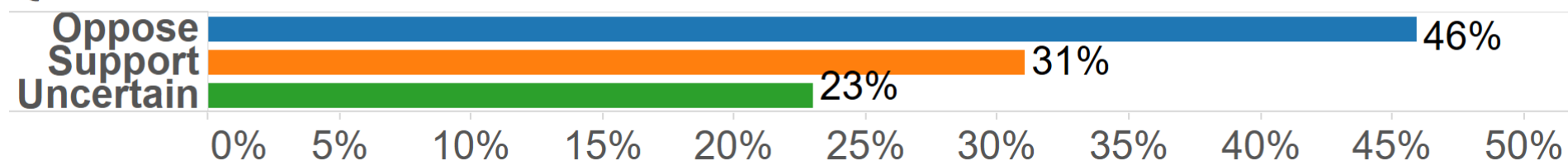

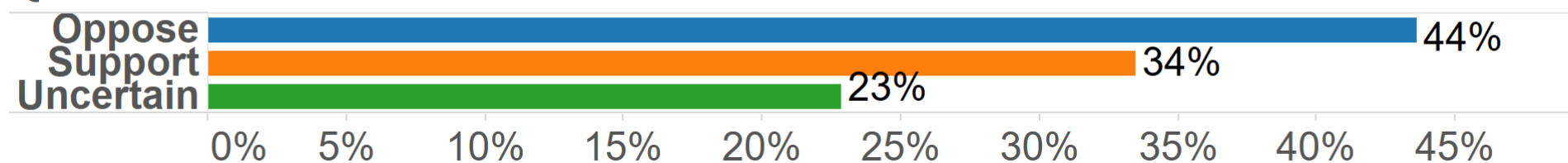

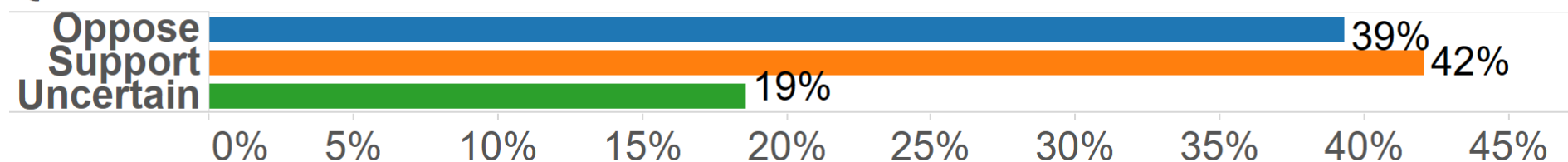

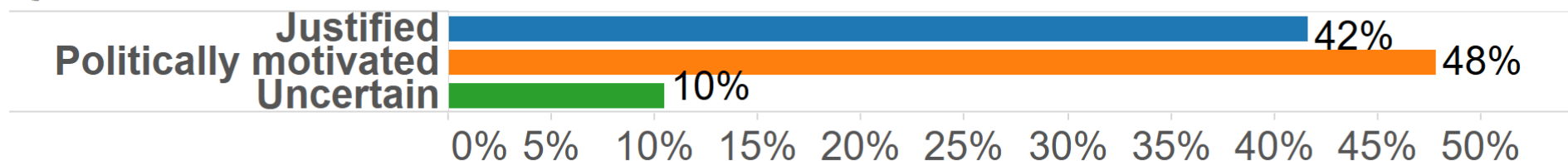

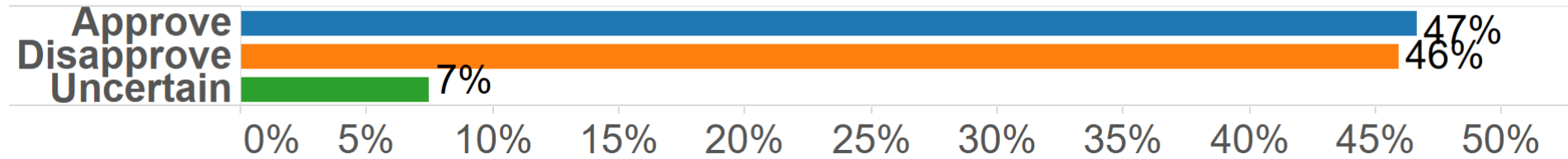

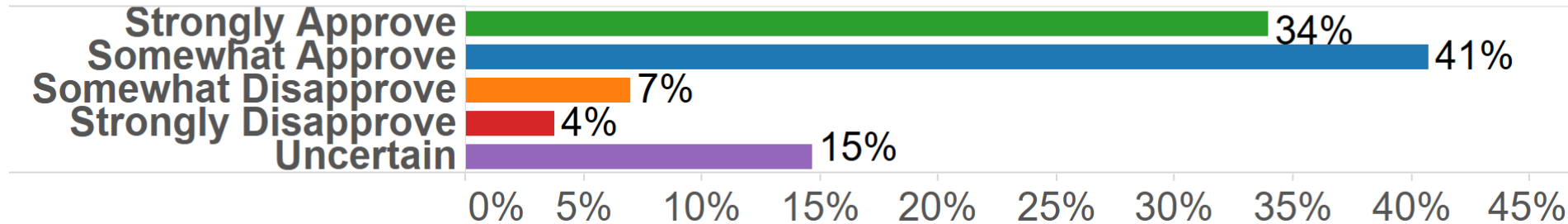

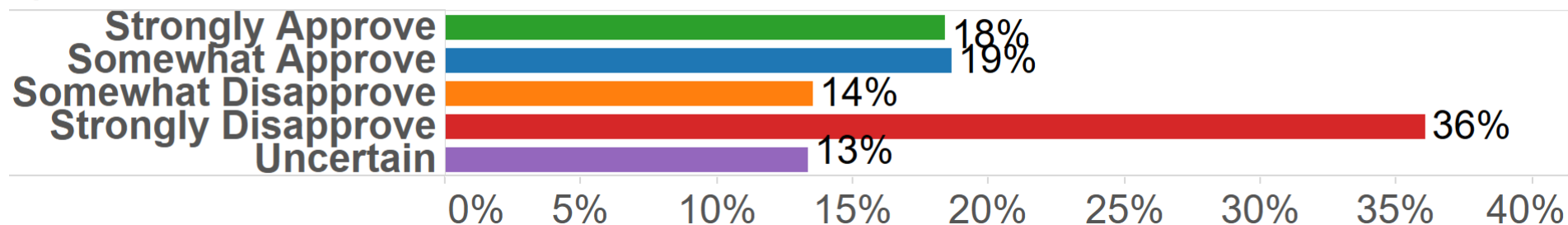

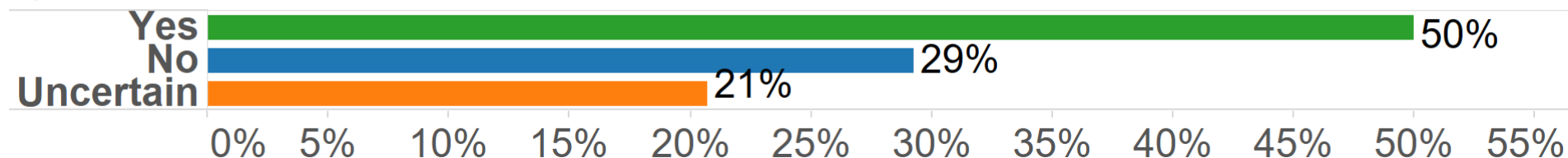

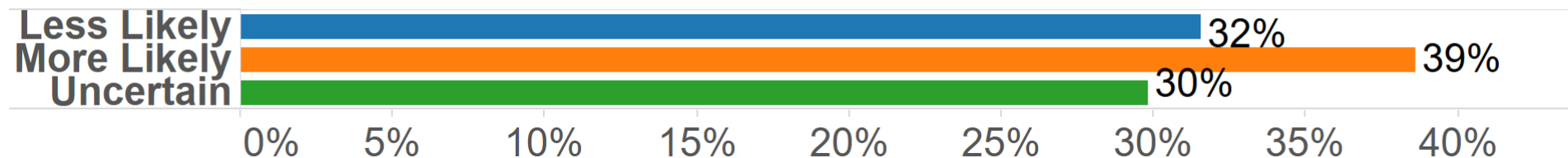

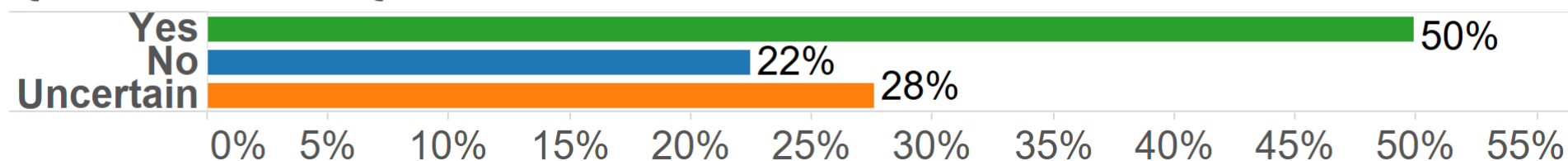

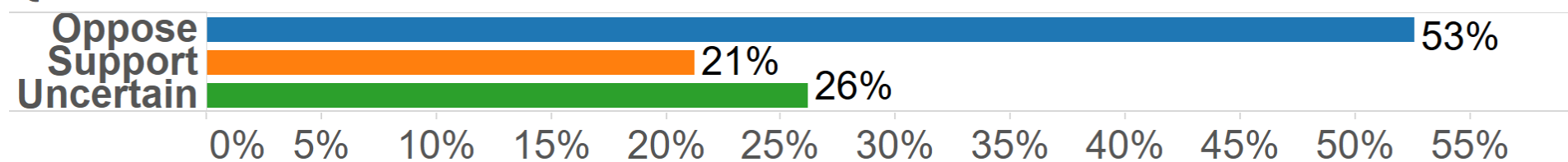

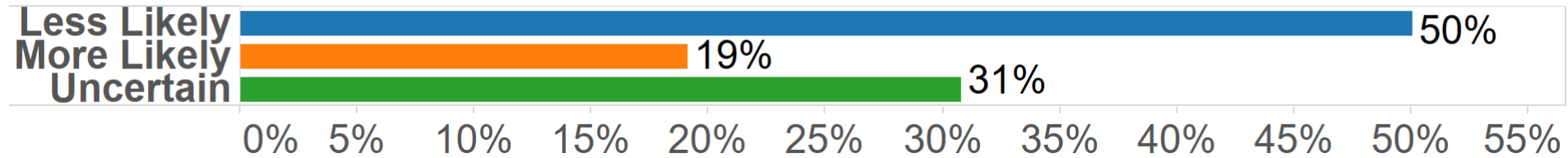

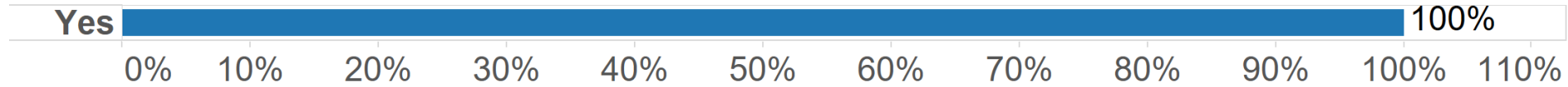

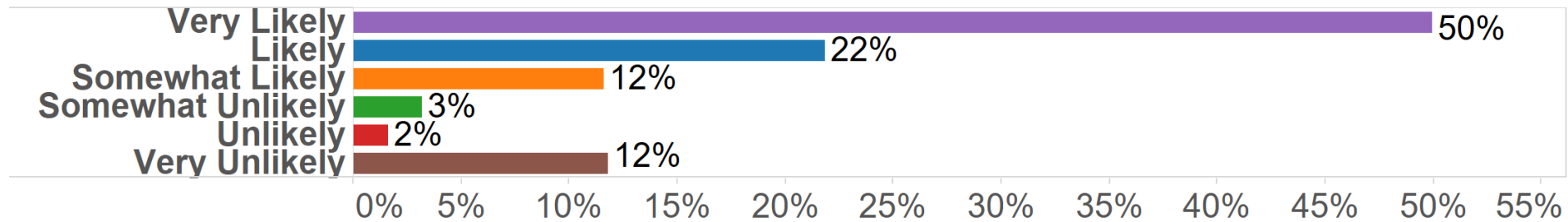

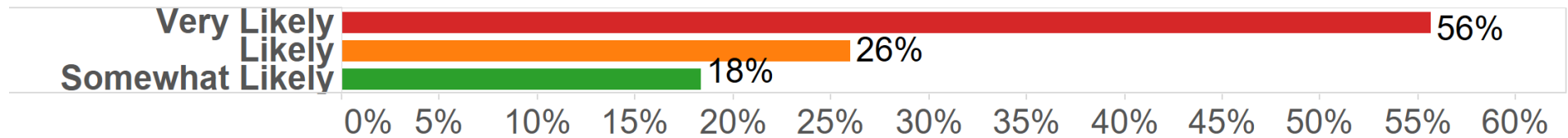
2) How likely are you to vote in the upcoming Delaware Primary Elections?

Q2: DELAWARE PRIMARY



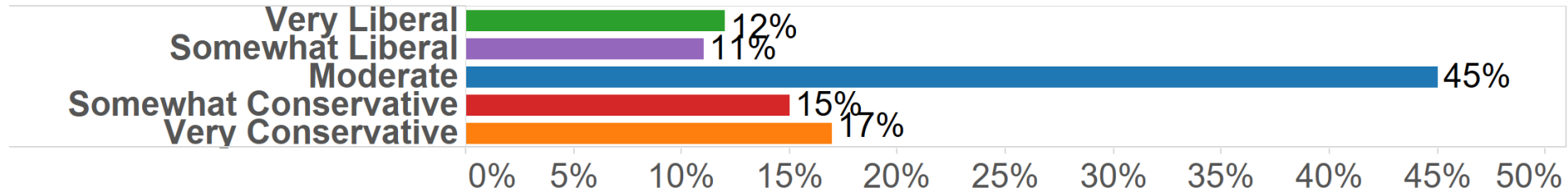

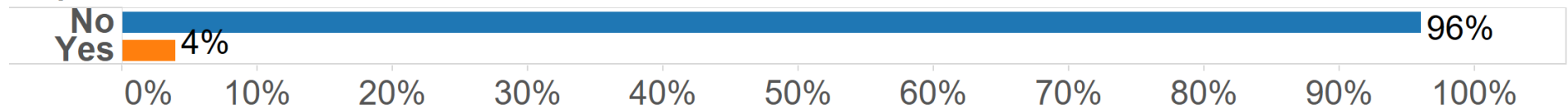

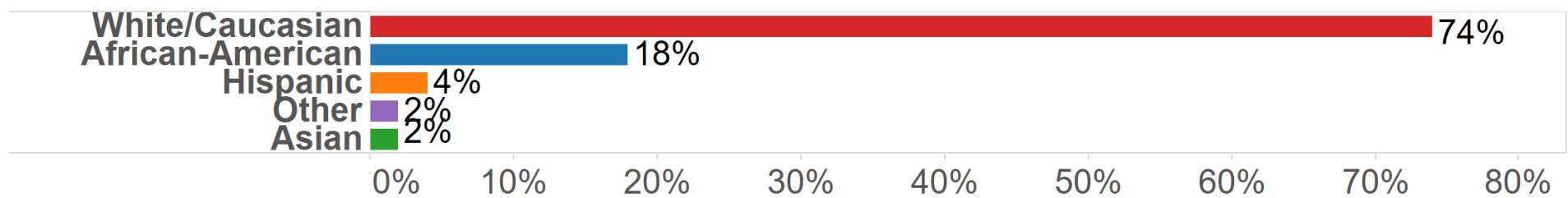

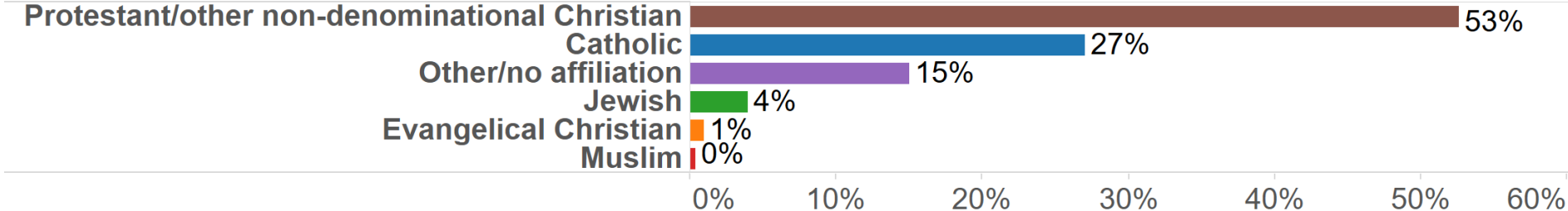

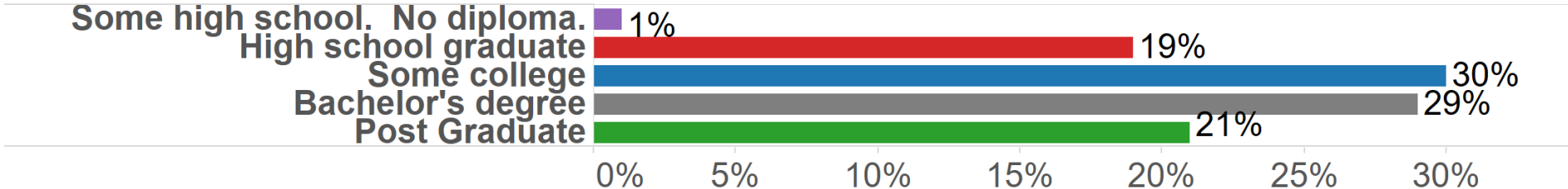

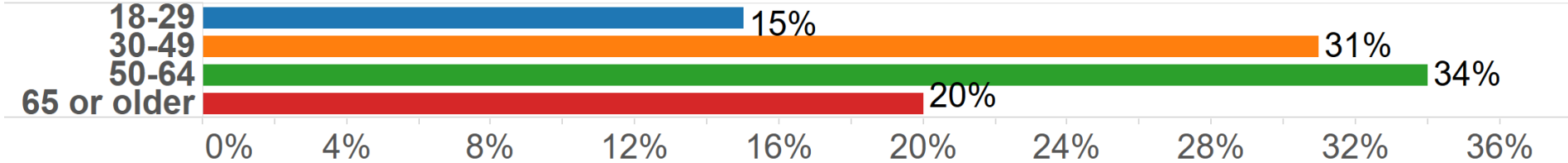
